



New security measures on liquid, gels and aerosols

The new security measure on liquids, gels and aerosols will be implemented in Macau International Airport on 1st March 2007.

- 1) The new procedures are applicable to liquids such as water, soups, syrups, juices and other drinks, and also to gels, pastes, lotions and the contents of aerosols. This includes toiletries such as toothpaste, shaving cream, hair gel, lip gloss, facial creams, mascara and liquid lip balms and any other solutions of similar consistency.
- 2) Please pay notice to the following restrictions if you require to carry liquids, gels and aerosols in your hand baggage when going through security checkpoints.

	
<p>100 ml or less containers of liquid/gel <u>More than 100ml permitted in checked in baggage</u></p>	<p>1 transparent resealable plastic bag of a maximum capacity not exceeding 1 liter (approx.20X20cm). <i>Pax are encouraged to bring their own plastic bags which meet the above criteria.</i></p>
	
<p>Items must fit comfortably in the bag</p>	<p><u>1 bag</u> per passenger and place the bag in the security tray for X ray.</p>

- 3) Prescription medications, baby formula/milk (2 years age and under) and duty free items purchased beyond the security screening point (with sealed pack and a valid sales receipt) are allowed in quantities exceeding 100ml and are not required to be in the zip-top bag. Declare these items for inspection at the checkpoint.
- 4) Passengers will be requested to take over their jacket/coats and take out their laptop computer for separate screening.
